What a great start to 2025! January has been a busy month and February promises to be much the same!

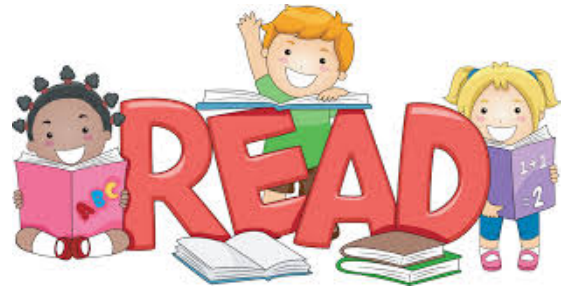


Please encourage your child to wear their warm clothes during recess.
